General instructions:												
1. Complete your match by the enddate indicated. Matches not complete by 8/29 will be scored as losses.												
2. Your assigned number is above your name.												
3. If your number is listed first on the match, you are the captain: arrange match date, time, location and reschedule if raining. If you don't reserve a court (taking a chance) make sure your opponent agrees.												
4. If your number is listed second on the match, you are the visitor: you supply balls and serve first.												
5. The captain shall email results (actual scores) to nanbg@rcn.com cc'ing the opponent.												
6. A 10-game pro set (1st to win 10 games), no-ad scoring, with up to a 5-minute warm-up, is to be played within 1-hour of court time. If the score ties at 9-9, a 9-point tiebreaker (1st to win 5) may be played with the first player serving once and each player serving twice thereafter.												
7. No-ad scoring means at deuce, the receiver decides which side the ball is served from and whoever wins the point wins the game.												
8. For every minute an opponent is late after the 5-minute grace (warm-up) period, the player on court is awarded a game. The late player is not given time to warm up. Only applies to reserved courts.												
9. Blatant foot-faults are called unless agreed to otherwise by both players.												
10. Matches are awarded points as follows: win = 2 points, tie = 1 point, loss = 0 points. Overall standing is based upon the total number of points won by August 29. Ties at the end of the season will be resolved by dividing the total games won divided by total games lost.												
11. There may be some un-used court time assigned for the league. Check the Battlegreentennis schedule and the tennis reservation letter from the town to see. Email bettylou@battlegreentennis.com to reserve one.
